day he did not come home.

Clinton, my dear husband, was
crushed against the wall of the
mines. He was killed in 1993.

His stepson and I were devastated
along with other family members
and many friends. I wondered
what I was supposed to do now.

Patriot promised to take care of the
widows along with all the other hard
next

working men and women that
worked every day.

Since that time I've had
heart attack and have a pacemaker,
a defibulator and diabetes. I need
my health card and I'm
praying you won't let Patriot Coal
steal our benefits they promised
all of us. Make Patriot take
responsibility and keep everything
that my husband worked for
and died for.

All the widows pensions
and miners pensions and health
benefits legally and rightfully
belong to us. Please Judge
make the right decision and
let us keep everything that
is entitled to us.
